

Talland House and Laity Directions

Talland House is very easy to find. From the harbour there is a bridge across Pol river with The House on Props next to it. Walk past The House on Props into Talland Street. The next door on the left is Laity and then Talland House. If you get to the House on Props before the harbour you have just passed us.

Polperro has narrow streets and can be busy during the day, normally from about 11am until 4pm. It is best to drive in to load / unload outside these times. You may find it easier to park and drive your car in after walking round. You cannot drive into Talland Street.

Unloading luggage and parking: Please leave the property name on the dash when parking.

Recommended if you have a lot of luggage. **MUST** Book in advance with Paul on 07794904239 Follow the directions below to the parking. Wait for the luggage taxi who can take one person and all your luggage right to the door. £15 each way (subject to change). You can also drop your passengers in the village.

Directions:

To enter the village directly follow the main road passing the Main Polperrom car park at the bottom of the hill. Go straight at the mini roundabout (Restricted Access).



The road narrows at the Cottage Restaurant



You then come to the lorry loading area. This is reserved for delivery lorries. If you unload here only do so in the evening when there are unlikely to be deliveries and the driver should stay with the car.



Continuing along the main road you pass The Ship pub. Follow the road turning right by the sweet shop and post office to Big Green with the war memorial. It is possible to unload here if not busy.



Access Only leads to the top of Talland Street but you may meet a car coming down and the only parking spot may be occupied so we do not recommend going up here.



From Big Green follow the road turning right, this is Landaviddy Lane. Continue uphill to the edge of the village. To walk is about 10 - 15 minutes up, 5 minutes down. Only the driver needs to do this! Just past the national speed limit signs you will see garages on your right.. Elm Cottage parking is on the left with a sign. There are two spaces with signs for Talland House and Laity. One space for each property.



Alternative:

This takes you to the top of Talland Street but not recommended.

This shows the main road to Polperro starting to descend to the right. 1 mile before Polperro. The main car park and village are at the bottom of the hill along the main bearing right. To drive to the top of Talland Street via Talland Hill turn left here.



Drive past the Holiday Park following the road which turns right at the end.



You pass Polperro School on your right just before the road narrows, DO NOT IGNORE THE 6ft 1.8m WIDTH. After 20 metres you turn left to the village.



This is Talland Hill.

These pictures show why not to ignore the width restriction, Folding mirrors will help.

It is very steep and to reverse will kill your clutch.



The top of Talland Street is on the left just past the phone box. You can reverse in and Talland House is 20m down Talland Street on the right. If the space is occupied pull in by the phone box. Remember to leave space for cars to pass.

From here, once unloaded, drive on down the road turning left at the bottom continuing from Big Green to the parking.




Alternative route to parking.
